TIMINGS

Gates open at 3pm
The Bonfire is lit at 5pm
First firework display 6pm
Second firework display 7.30pm
Event closes at 9pm

If you are planning on watching the first display we highly recommend that you arrive by 4pm. Our Bonfire & Fireworks Night is one of the largest in the region and there will be significant traffic on the roads.

TICKETS

Admission is ticketed at a per person rate.

When buying your tickets please add the Car Pass (free) to your basket. This helps us to manage the car parks on the evening.

A Car Pass is NOT a ticket and on its own will not gain admission to the event.

Access to the event is by car only there is strictly no pedestrian admission for health and safety reasons.

Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable.

If you have not received your ticket please check your spam folders – they tend to hide in there!

EARLY BIRD TICKETS

Adult £14 per person

Children £7 (4-14 years) per person

Under 4's go free and don't require a ticket

Available for a limited time, once we have reached our allocation Standard Admission will apply

STANDARD ADMISSION

Adult £17 per person

Child £10 (4-14 years) per person

Under 4's go free and don't require a ticket

WESTON PARK MEMBERS

£12 per person

Under 4's go free and don't require a ticket

Carers Concessions:

If you are a registered carer you receive free entry. Please purchase one ticket for the person you care for and bring the relevant paperwork with you.

- Admission to Weston Park's Bonfire & Fireworks Night is by advanced ticket only. There will be NO tickets available on the night.

- Please have your tickets ready to be scanned. You can print them or simply present on your phone.

PARKING

Our car parks are on grass and you will be directed by the Event Traffic Control team.

Please wear suitable footwear, wellies or boots are a must, wrap up warm and bring in a torch.

Blue Badge Holders

Please display your Blue Badge on arrival to Weston before you reach the entrance to enable the parking team to identify that you need to be directed to the designated accessible parking area.

The car park is a 10 - 15 minute walk from the Bonfire & Fireworks show site.

ENTERTAINMENT

Scream if you want to go faster! Bill Chipperfield will be bringing one of the largest fun fairs in the region with rides for all ages. Rides typically cost £5 - £12 per person. Whilst most operators take card payments we strongly advise you bring some cash with you. We don't have a cash machine on site.

FOOD & DRINK

A large food court will surround the bonfire with the following on the menu; classic burgers, wraps, loaded fries, hog roast, fried chicken, donuts, crepes, sweets, hot chocolate, coffee and much more! Hobsons Brewery will be serving local award-winning ales, cider and winter cocktails.

GENERAL

There are no cash machines on-site please bring both cash and cards
